Puppy Feeding

Pups are active, growing animals and use huge amounts of energy in their rapid growth. They also have very little energy reserves, like fat, compared to adult dogs. This means that they require more calories per gram of food than adult dogs. They also have higher protein and vitamin / mineral requirements.

We have found the easiest way to meet growing pups' requirements is to feed a complete and balanced "puppy" or "growth" diet such as those offered by premium foods



such as, Hills, Royal Canin or Eukanuba. Surprisingly it is often cheaper to feed a premium dry diet than to feed canned food or dog roll. Talk to your vet or one of our nurses about the best food for your pup. When feeding a premium diet it is not necessary to add any supplements to the food.
