

## Puppy Worming

Regular worming of dogs not only helps keep them healthy, it can keep you healthy as well. Tapeworms are less of a risk now than thirty years ago, largely due to organised hydatids dosing of dogs, and the feeding of cooked or frozen meat and offal. Worming with **Endogard All wormer** is the most effective preventative measure.



Tapeworms usually aren't a concern in puppies. For pups, the most abundant and dangerous worm is the roundworm. A large number of roundworms are passed onto the pups by the bitch during pregnancy and in the milk when pups feed. This is why it is so important to regularly worm pups up until they are fourteen to sixteen weeks old. Pups should be wormed with a roundworm worming pill such as **Endogard** every two weeks from birth. Roundworm from puppies can also unfortunately infect children if they come into contact with dog faeces, eg children's sand pit. If you have puppies and children in the same household it is most important to be aware of hygiene and to keep puppy worming up to date. From three months of age your puppy needs to be wormed every three months forever.
