

## WORMING-Kittens

Regular worming of cats not only keeps them healthy, it can keep you healthy as well.

Roundworms are the most abundant and dangerous worms in kittens. Unfortunately, these worms can also be picked up by children if they handle cats' faeces. For this reason it is important to have a litter tray available for your kittens to use, and to change the litter regularly. Good hygiene is the best protection.

A large number of roundworms are passed onto the kittens by their mother at a young age. For this reason kittens should be wormed every two weeks until they are around four months old. The best choice of worming for this is a roundworm tablet.

From four months onward an adult cat wormer for cats should be used.
